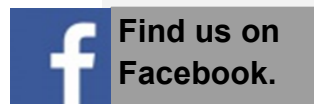

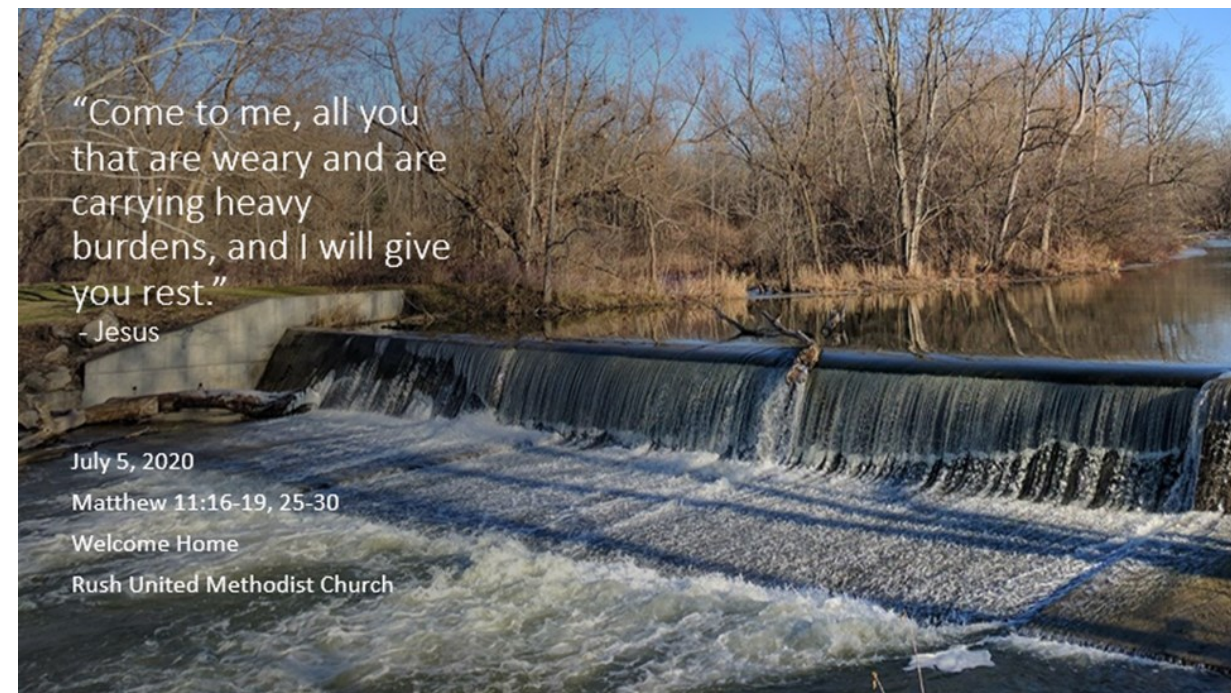
### ***Puzzle and Book Exchange***
